

My Friend Ben (AL Fike)



Almost a year ago, Jeanne, Geoff and I set out for Namibia. It was a truly God-guided and blessed trip. I must admit, however, that I felt some trepidation when we set out to visit the Drimiopsis camp where Helge is in the process of building an orphanage. I have seen lots of poverty in our travels to third world countries, but feared my reflexive reactions which are a combination of anguish for the conditions, guilt for what I have, and some repulsion towards those living in such deprivation -- a typical western reaction to such situations. When we arrived, I felt exactly as anticipated. I was choked up most of the time -- even as the people greeted us with open arms and joyous smiles.

One person stood out from the crowd and struck me deep within my heart. His name was Ben. He was an orphan 12 or 13 years old with disabilities probably resulting from Fetal

Alcohol Syndrome, since alcoholism is rampant in the camp. He was living rough in the bush and his clothes were torn and dirty. Yet, he was one of the first to greet us with a smile and a 'how are you?' When we asked how he was, he would always say that he was fine. Ben loved to give high fives and considered himself a sort of ambassador showing us around and staying close wherever we went. Helge had a special interest in him and his plight and mothered him as much as she was able.

Kids like Ben are victims in many ways with no parents, no shelter and very little to sustain them. Everyone in the camp has the daily challenge to survive, but Ben's challenges were increased by his mental disabilities. He was one of the lowest of the low, a scape goat for the other kids who picked on him, and often beaten up by the older kids who used him to vent their own frustrations. He was bottom of the heap, and what he endured would have been beyond any of our abilities to comprehend. Yet, despite the bruises and scars, Ben possessed an amazing compassion and caring. He reached out to us in loving ways and emanated a love which immediately drew me to him. I also recognized in him something that was also in me – that special pain that is wrought from being different and alone. As a child I too felt that pain, not fitting in and being the victim of bullying and harassment. There was a resonance, and as we continued to bond with him, we felt like we needed to lift him out of this hell. I wanted to rescue him by taking him home with us. My heart was that moved by his plight and my own need to heal him and maybe heal myself as well in the process. It was a powerful pull and it haunts me even today.

Recently Ben passed over into spirit after a short illness. My heart is broken for Ben and this inevitable fate of the lost child that he was. He lives on in my mind with very fond memories but I feel a remorse that maybe we could have saved him. The practicalities of such things are onerous and complex. It is one thing to wish to rescue someone and another to actually do it. My desire to enfold him and bring him into our world may have been too much for both Ben and us. We'll never know as he is now in a different, and I hope, more loving place. Ben's physical difficulties are no more. I hope that now his loving spirit can be expressed in all its beauty and strength.

Ben, may you find peace, my dear friend, in a world more suited for you. A world where love is a greater currency than physical strength and power. You passed over into a world where you are wealthy and this will carry you far into greater light. You have been set free. Someday we will meet again and you can tell me all about your adventures in spirit. We will high five each other and smile in recognition of our soul bond. I wish you well on your journey my dear sensitive boy, and I will keep you in my thoughts and prayers. I will always remember the time when you stroked my arm and gave me strength and comfort as I talked to the elders. You may have done so out of curiosity because your people are not so hairy, but for me it was a comfort and it told me much about who you are. I remember later that day our dear guide Confucius mentioned you in a message during our prayer. He said: "Like the dear soul who patted this instrument's arm, his love was felt. Is he not a channel of God's Love? This simple and vulnerable child gave love."

Yes, you gave love my brave child, even when you were in a place of no love. You are the strongest soul I have ever met. It will be your gift and strength as you move forward. My love is with you. You have taught me much in a very short time and you will remain in my heart always. With love and gratitude, Al.

Manifestation of God's Healing Powers (Holly Bianco)

As a registered nurse who has cared for many patients with infectious diseases, I'm grateful for having been blessed with good health. This may be due to more than a strong immunity – perhaps I've been protected by God's healing powers throughout the years. The following is a testimony to divine healing powers and the work of God's angels in my life.

Many years ago I had a bad respiratory infection which I feared was developing into pneumonia. I was thinking of going to the ER to seek medical help, but decided instead to just go to bed to rest and pray. That night I saw an Indian guide beside me. When I awoke the next morning, I felt better and continued to improve until I was completely healed. Since then, I have occasionally seen Indian guides with me, including an Indian Chief in full head-dress.



I experienced another healing intervention ten years later, after the birth of my son by C-section. Two weeks after the surgery, I had an infection with a high fever and had to be hospitalized. The doctor said I couldn't leave the hospital until 24 hours after my fever subsided. I already had a persistent fever three days prior to my hospital admission, and now after two days in the hospital, it wasn't abating. The triple antibiotics infusing into my veins seemed slow in working. I became scared that I wouldn't see my newborn son for many days, so I started to earnestly pray. I could feel my soul go out to the Father and with it came an immediate response — He heard my plea! Right then, I felt a cold sensation passing through me starting from the back of my head. As it passed through my brain and head, these authoritative words came to me: "This will be your last fever." I knew instantly that I would get better and sure enough, it was my last fever! I was able to go home 24 hours later. Thank you Heavenly Father! I was so happy to be reunited with my baby boy whom I hadn't seen for three days.

For me as a nurse working in a hospital setting, it is hard to say whether any of my patients had experienced healing due to God's power or just medical intervention. However, I believe that I did see a healing intervention with a couple of patients.

One evening, my night shift was scheduled in the Intensive Care Unit. While I was charting on my own patient, I heard a male patient yelling out bizarre things. My soul immediately responded with compassion towards this man, and then came to me these words as if from God: "Holly, this young man should not be here. Go to his bedside and take all your high influences with you." I walked in his direction and could feel my spirit band with me. As I was asking him questions, he kept repeating, "Mommy, can you pick me up?"

Besides being in restraints for mental impairment, he also had a lot of respiratory secretions. I learned from the other nurses that they ran tests on him including CT/MRI and drug screening and couldn't find anything to explain why he was acting the way he was. In fact, the patient's nurse told me he was a very intelligent guy who worked on computers. I also learned that his room-mate was into some form of witchcraft.

I took an interest in him and used a device to help suction his oral secretions. (Sorry – it may sound gross but that's what we do.) I found he was able to follow some directions, and remarked to the other nurses that he needed to be encouraged to cough up his secretions. One very experienced ICU nurse, who is able to foretell if patients are getting worse, told me emphatically, "I know he is going to be intubated soon!" (meaning placed on a ventilator).

After that night, I was off work for two days. When I came back to my regular unit which was below the ICU, I ended up caring for this same patient. I told the nurse who gave report on him, "Oh I know this guy – he's crazy." When she said, "He is not crazy and doing very well," I was shocked! That's right, even I had doubts. Not only was the experienced ICU nurse wrong in her prediction of him needing a ventilator, but his mental faculties were restored, he was speaking appropriately, and was now suctioning his own secretions. His mind was clear and he was on his way to a full physical recovery.

I truly believe this young man was possessed by earthbound spirits, and my following guidance to bring angelic influences around him helped to rid him of those spirits. The most interesting thing was how God and His angels led me to this man. It wasn't like I went over to his bedside to try to help him; he wasn't my patient. Instead, I was guided to go there because the angels knew he could be set free from the dark or lost spirits. I should not have doubted but believed in my guidance. I'm sure the angels were pleased that I was able to see his improvement. If I hadn't seen this patient again, I would not have known about his recovery.

I had a similar experience with another male patient who was brought to the hospital after being found on a nearby hillside half-naked and acting very bizarre. He had to be put in restraints for his own protection. I expected him to remain physically restrained for at least 2-3 days, especially if he was going through withdrawal from alcohol or DT's.

Once again, this patient was not my patient, but a co-worker was to look after him. We were both working the night shift. That night my co-worker was at his bedside and then began to walk to the nursing area where I was standing. Immediately I felt a terrible fear and apprehension, as well as feelings of frustration. Then scary thoughts passed through my mind – negative thoughts and anger towards my co-worker. I couldn't understand why I should have such emotions. He is a good guy! I told myself that these cannot be my thoughts or feelings – this is not me! As soon as I acknowledged that these weren't my thoughts or emotions, they left me and I was no longer afraid.

Really amazing to me was how fast that patient recovered. His behavior changed and the restraints were removed. I then knew he must have been possessed by dark spirits, maybe a legion of them, who tried to attack me as they were leaving the

patient, but were unsuccessful. I'm sure my angel guides helped me with these dark spirits as I know they protect me, as well as bringing healing.

I'm grateful for all the protection God and His angels have given me and for the healing powers they have displayed in my life. I pray that God will bless and protect all who read this. May our Heavenly Father's Love and His powers manifest in each of our lives and may our faith in Him increase.

EARLY HISTORY OF THE DIVINE LOVE MOVEMENT IN WESTERN CANADA (DARLENE GAUNT)



Alec and Phyllis were both seekers of truth and had researched many of the world religions and spiritual beliefs. In 1949, Alec discovered in a North Vancouver bookstore one of the Padgett books, published by the Foundation Church of the New Birth in the 1940s. He was drawn to this book because he saw a light around it. Soon after reading it, Alec and Phyllis began praying for God's Divine Love. Not long after this they knew they had found the truth that they had been searching for. They then dedicated their lives to God, wanting to be used as instruments of His Divine Love.

Alec began 24 discussion groups where he spoke to people and read the Padgett messages. He was a naturally gifted promoter, and this with his personal integrity and conviction of the

truth of the Divine Love enabled him to attract many to the Divine Love path. Over time, Alec became known for forwarding the truths and especially the Padgett books to various people. In addition to working with the groups, over the course of years he spoke at numerous churches and gave many lectures.

Through the power of the groups that prayed weekly for God's Divine Love, there arose over a few years two gifted mediums, Alice Demures and Rose Crane MacDonnell. They were able to bring through the higher teachers and even Jesus who imparted many uplifting messages regarding God's Divine Love and the spiritual and divine laws of God.

Dr. Leslie Stone came to visit Alec and Phyllis in Vancouver three times. He was brought to Vancouver by Lanktree Thompson, a great advocate of the work. Dr. Stone, Dr. Daniel Samuels and the Vancouver group continued with the Divine Love work for many years. There is much evidence of this work in Dr. Samuels and Dr. Stone's writings.

Phyllis had developed psychic gifts and was blessed with the gift of trance mediumship. Alec, already a gifted psychic, developed a gift of healing and had helped many people. Many healings and much work was done through the various groups that formed until Alec's passing to spirit in 1970. Alec continues his work from the Celestial Heavens supporting and helping his family and his spiritual family on earth.

One of the groups that Alec started in Vancouver has survived to this day because of Divine Love followers and mediums, Ellie and Barbara, who continued the prayer circle after Alec's death. This prayer circle changed over time but continued on thanks to the dedication of Barb and a few other Divine Love followers who have prayed together for over four decades. Members of this group include a few of the founders of the Divine Love Sanctuary Foundation, Al and Jeanne Fike.

In 1970, Phyllis Gaunt became an ordained minister with the International Spiritualist Alliance in Vancouver. She remarried to become the wife of Percy Hayes, who had become a Divine Love follower after discovering the Padgett work through Alec and Phyllis. Percy was ordained in 1972 in the Universal Brotherhood Spiritualist Church.

Phyllis and Percy moved to Edmonton, Alberta where they lived for about 20 years. They worked together, speaking at numerous schools and churches, and many people received the truths of the Padgett messages. They also held weekly prayer groups at their home with interested seekers, and Phyllis gave readings.

In 1984, Percy and Phyllis were both ordained through the Foundation Church of Divine Truth. Shortly after this, they returned to the greater Vancouver area and settled in Surrey. There they again both gave readings at their home, as well as speaking at churches, in particular the First United Spiritualist Church in Burnaby, BC. In 1994, they were ordained with the Foundation Church of the New Birth and served as trustees for many years.

Percy and Phyllis conceived of and starred in their own television show called "The Psychics". The program was produced by a local community television station and aired throughout the greater Vancouver area. Its format was that of a call-in talk show where people phoned in to ask questions. In answering, Percy and Phyllis shared many spiritual truths and laws of God, believing that the laws fit every soul. They taught that everyone was psychic and that psychic gifts were gifts from God to help us through the maze of life. The show ran weekly from 1992 until late 2000 and was positively received. Due to Phyllis' declining health, Percy worked alone from about 1999 to 2000 with a name change of the show to "The Psychic". Phyllis passed to spirit in 2000. She was a very spiritual person who always loved and supported her family and helped many souls onto the Path Divine.

From about 1998 to 2001, Percy worked as "Santa Claus", mostly at the Guildford Town Centre Shopping Centre in Surrey, BC, where he became known and beloved as the "Guildford Santa". Percy had played Santa for a number of charitable events during the years, including the annual "Christmas in July" sponsored by the Surrey Firefighters in conjunction with the Surrey Food Bank.

Percy experienced his own "Christmas in July" on his 84th birthday on July 29, 2015 thanks to a very special gift from Shawn Slavin of Victoria. Shawn was one of the children that visited Percy as Santa at Guildford Town Centre for over a decade, and now in his early 20s discovered

that Percy lived in the same nursing home as his great-aunt. He decided to pay tribute to Percy in a Facebook post asking all those who knew him as the "real Santa" to send him a card for his upcoming birthday, to thank him for all of the love and joy he gave to so many. This posting went viral and many thousands paid tribute to Percy. He was interviewed on the CBC News and featured in local newspapers. Percy received hundreds of birthday cards and many visits and presents.

Percy's gifts touched many as he reached out to every soul he met. For decades of his life, he was used as an instrument of healing through God's great Love and light.

PADGETT MESSAGE

TGRABJ, Vol II, P. 269

Important that Man Must Search and Find the Truth.

I am here, John.

I desire to write tonight, and if you think it is not too late, we will do so. Well, I will not make my message very lengthy, but try to condense it in short sentences.

I want to tell you that when a man gets to know the truths of the Father, he will become a very happy and wise man, for these truths have in them only those principles that create happiness and wisdom.

I know that men believe many things on account of their being ancient or having the authority of their forefathers, or some great saint or writer who lived many centuries ago, but such a basis for truth, while worthy of consideration and examination does not of itself, because of being old, afford any certainty that what is thus accepted contains the truth.

Truth is a thing very old, and existed for many thousands of centuries before the times in which these ancient writers, as you call them, lived, and in fact, those days of the writers, in comparison to what had gone before, are as yesterdays; and therefore you will see that because the declarations of these writers are what you consider very ancient, they should not be received as having authority.

Truths of those days, and of the long ages prior thereto, and of the present time are all the same, as truth never changes or assumes new forms no matter what the conditions of mortals may be as to intellectual or spiritual development. And they may be revealed today, and are being constantly revealed as time progresses, and should be accepted with as much credence and satisfaction as any truths that were ever disclosed in ancient days. Men are just as susceptible now to the reception of these truths in their spiritual natures or perceptions as they were in the times of Abraham or Moses or at any time since.

The mind of man was given to him to be exercised in the way of investigation and search, and never was it contemplated in his creation that the time would come when he should accept anything as the ultimates of truth and cease his inquiries, for truths are so many and great and deep, that so far, in the mortal universe, man has acquired only a smattering of these truths. And to rest supinely in this acquirement under the belief that there is nothing more in existence than man may know, violates and subverts the very object of his creation; and what I have said applies to spiritual truths as well as to material ones.

The churches, I know, declare and try to enforce the declaration, that it is not possible to discover or have revealed to men the essential principles of spiritual truths to a greater extent than has already been declared in the Bible and the churches' interpretation of the same, and that, therefore, it is contrary to God's will that men should seek further for any additional truths, and that men should accept, without question, the sayings of the Bible, and the dogmas and creeds of the churches which their claim is founded upon, and which they declare are the true principles of spiritual truths. And for many years this has been the demand of the churches, and the members thereof have acquiesced, without question or doubt.

Now, this has been one of the great causes why men have not progressed more, not only in their spiritual nature but also in what may be called their natural qualities. They have remained satisfied, and what was believed by them centuries ago are believed today. I say all this to show how stagnant the intellects of men have been, as it depends on search and investigation, and has remained so for all these long ages. I further recite this to show the necessity for men to seek and criticize, and accept or reject as the results of the search may demand.

In recent years though, men have made greater progress, and the individual has come to the front and the old accepted fabrications of truths have been assaulted and shaken and denuded of their falsities to a considerable degree, and so it should be. Men must seek, and criticize and accept or reject as their own conscience and reasoning powers dictate, and therein will be freedom of the mind as well as of the will.

The soul, also, has been smothered in these dogmatic beliefs, and as a consequence its development has been slow, and knowledge of things spiritual has not come to men as it should have done, and as is necessary to teach them their destiny and the truths which should control their lives on earth, and which will control their progress in the spirit world.

Well, as you are tired, I will postpone the balance of my discourse. I think it best when you feel tired to discontinue the writing instead of attempting to force yourself into receiving it.

So I will not write more. Believe that I am your brother in Christ.
