DLSF Soul Awakening Retreats: Australia and Hawaii 2019 (Jeanne Fike)

Thanks to our generous hosts, Geoff Cutler, Susan and Michael Lytton-Hitchins, and Peter and Clare Heibloem, DLSF facilitated five Divine Love Retreats in Sydney, Fitzroy Falls (New South Wales), Eudlo (Sunshine Coast, Queensland) and Hawaii in November and December. Altogether we introduced our practice of praying for Divine Love to about 50 new spiritual seekers who were open to hearing about the Truths of God's Greatest Gift of Divine Love and the possibility of Soul Awakening. With the personal presence of three Divine Love mediums and a worldwide army of prayerful warriors

supporting our efforts from afar, we prayed for an hour each morning and afternoon. We were guided by a band of Celestial angels who were eager to connect with those of us struggling on the earth plane to be in the flow of God's will. Over the five weeks, we received 124 Celestial messages of Love, Divine Truths, encouragement and healing. The voice recordings of the messages were posted daily in WhatsApp — LightBringers Group, and are slowly being transcribed for our website and Mailchimp. (Volunteers are needed to help transcribe!)

Jimbeau Walsh led us into prayers for Divine Love with his beautiful songs helping to bring everyone together into harmony and raising the condition of love and light at each gathering. The angels worked hard "behind the scenes", bringing seeking souls to learn about Divine Love and pray with us. There was a great diversity of experiences and beliefs among the attendees. Every one of the 17 participants on the Sunshine Coast, for example, was deeply impacted by the teachings of A.J. Miller. As a result, a significant number of the messages received there were in response to A.J.'s teachings. We were delighted that Terry Anderson came all the way from Christchurch, New Zealand, bringing his great enthusiasm and wonderful sense of humor that lightened up the Q & A (Question and Answer) sessions.

We expect DLSF Soul Awakening trips to Australia to become an annual event, and likely extend to Christchurch, N.Z. We are humbled by God's bountiful blessings and the blessings of our dear angel friends who are able to come closer and closer to us with each prayer.

Highlights of Retreats in Australia

Portals of Light are being built and strengthened in Sydney, Fitzroy Falls and Eudlo. Susan and Clare are being developed as Divine Love mediums who will be able to bring messages during the coming earth changes. A Lattice of Light is being created amongst Divine Love followers in Australia in response to continuous prayers for Divine Love. Jimbeau Walsh performed a wedding vow renewal ceremony on the beautiful Makaha Beach, honoring Karen and Randy Lyons.

Just a few short weeks after hosting the weekend retreat facilitated by the Fikes in Fitzroy Falls, Susan and Michael Lytton-Hitchins' home came under threat from one of the fires in the area. Here are some of Susan's sobering reflections shortly before Christmas.

We are still under threat [of the nearby fire], and the authorities are keeping all the local community informed and working together which will give the best chance for saving property and lives.

We remain on high alert, but so far we are one of the very fortunate ones. However, from what we can gather, the south-coast fire has just come up the escarpment and is at Burrawang, so it is now only four kilometers away, although the wind is currently carrying it away from us. From Bowral to Sydney, the Blue Mountains thru to Lithgow are alight and totally out of control as I write this, with winds around 90 km an hour and 41 degrees [106 degrees F] heat. This is just one of hundreds of fires in NSW, some are thousands of kilometers wide. More than 800 houses and four lives lost. Temperatures are supposed to drop dramatically tomorrow which will bring relief.

I am praying for strength as I find the loss and destruction of wildlife, the environment, property, and life very distressing. I realize that I can be of no use or support to anyone if I am a mess myself! I am sure God and the angels are walking with me – it is not fear, but terrible grief that seems to be so overwhelming. Prayers, prayers, and more prayers is all Michael and I can do right now. I was told that in prayer we will be safe, so I trust this, but equally must play our role, taking responsibility and helping others where we can.

Bless you all for your concern. More Canadians and Americans arrived to help today – certainly we are all brothers and sisters with such a global response. Ten thousand volunteers and fire fighters in the fire zones today gives you some idea of the massive undertaking in progress.

The following day Susan wrote:

Today the temperature has dropped 20 degrees with mist and smoky conditions and they are promising a little respite from the heat of 40+ at least until the end of next week. So this will bring relief to the fire fighters that are very fatigued. The prayers of so many are very gratefully received -- certainly the whole Country needs inches of rain to break the drought and stop the fires, but even a little relief is a blessing.

It has been a very poignant experience for me reflecting just how important it truly is for us to gain inner strength, faith and guidance through the receival of Divine Love. Some of the recent messages have asked how well prepared we are, and how strong we feel. We obviously do not have any real idea of what lies ahead and what we will be subjected to with so much possible devastation all around us. All of our Divine Love Community may be seriously tested if this current experience in Australia is anything to go by. Michael and I have not even been directly in the firing line like others — losing home and everything. Just imagine, trying to support others in all the chaos if our own circumstances are equally affected! I pray that

God will escalate my progress so I am better prepared as I have been very emotionally distressed. We need to consider that we may not have physical contact with our online Divine Love Community either, for that immeasurable support that Michael and I have had at this time, as the world goes through its transformation. It is pretty sobering to consider what may be required to bring the Earth to balance and humanity back to God.

In closing, a little bit of Aussie humour. Seen in a paddock along a nearby road: "12 empty dams, advertising for a professional rain dancer. Apply within; I will supply gum boots & a raincoat!

On December 29, Susan added: All the prayers are helping I'm sure and we are most grateful for so much support; I am pleased to say I am feeling much stronger to cope with whatever eventuates, and we are getting a lot of guidance and support from the Angels, so we are truly blessed in such a threatening situation.

On one occasion that I shall never forget, I met a man with a wooden leg. In

December 1975, just before Christmas, we both found ourselves stranded near Denver, Colorado. I had been in Houston, Texas staying with Jocelyn Harleston and was on my way to Boise, Idaho to visit my mother.

The outside temperature was nine degrees Fahrenheit and it was snowing. I drove off the freeway down the hill and suddenly, no brakes! It was a miracle that there was no other car on the road and that I managed to make a left turn to drive up a hill to a motel near the freeway.

I was waiting in line at the motel desk to get a room and standing behind me was a Vietnam vet with a wooden leg. When it came my turn to get a room, there was only one room left with two double beds. The guy with the wooden leg heard the conversation and asked me if he could share the room with me. Here I was a single woman, 24 years old, alone, and a man I didn't know from Adam asking me if he could share my motel room with me! For some reason I didn't hesitate and said

okay. Thinking back, I don't know what possessed me to agree to share my motel room with him. One thing is for sure -- I was very lucky.

A few minutes after we arrived in the room, the guy asked me, "Would you mind if I take my leg off?" I replied "What?" "I have a wooden leg and want to know if it would be okay with you if I took my leg off?" So I said okay, and he pulled up his pant leg and unhooked his leg and laid it on the table.

Well, a long story short, I ended up telling this man about the amazing messages and how they were actually Jesus' second coming to earth. He was so blown away by what I shared that he called his wife and told her "I just met this girl and she is telling me the most amazing things." And he mentioned to her that he was sharing a motel room with me. I had some of the volumes with me and he took one of them.

He lived in Colorado and was on his way to Tennessee to visit his little boy for Christmas. Because of the divorce laws in Tennessee, his son couldn't go to Colorado and visit him. However, after I told him of these amazing messages, he could not wait to go back and see his wife.

I often think about the man with the wooden leg and wonder if he made it to Tennessee that Christmas in 1975 to see his little son – and what happened to the boy? Did he tell him about me and what I shared with him about Jesus? Did he pass his book onto someone else? Did he share what he learned from the book?

We never know what happens after we have passed onto others these spiritual teachings. It is such an honor and privilege to be able to do this, and the Divine Angels of the Kingdom realize how important it is for us to express ourselves and share the amazing legacy that has been given to us.

I have given people one of our books and they go on their merry way and I never see them again. I have always wondered what happened with those people. With some that I have met, I never shared because the opportunity didn't present itself. However, some of those people have since passed on and have come back and visited me. I feel certain that because of my brief association with them, many of my own family members and friends on the other side have gone to them, introduced themselves, and shared this ministry with them. I have been told that because of my connection with them, many of those people have progressed to the Kingdom. So even though we do not always have the opportunity to share with people we meet on our journey, they may in some indirect way eventually find themselves heading to the Kingdom because of having come in contact with us.

An acquaintance of mine recently passed over. One of my friends in spirit came to me and told me that in a few weeks he will go to him, introduce himself, tell him he is a friend of mine, and then tell him about this ministry.

Whenever we feel discouraged, this is something we can be assured of. Even though we don't always have the chance to express what we know to the people we meet, a time will come when some of those people will progress to the Kingdom because of our contact with them. They will remember meeting us and find out what we had to offer them, even if we didn't tell them, or they rejected the given information. One day, they will realize their error and listen.

Distinguished Businessman, Loving of Community,
Passionate in His Service to His Fellowman,
Strict, but Fair in His Personal and Business Dealings,
And Dedicated to His Creator in His Quest for Truth.

Katheryn shared some personal reflections which we are publishing with her permission.

Page and I were married 41 years when he passed at the age of 80. His life was very rich and he was very supportive of everything I ventured into. Most of my endeavours were not successful, but I learned something valuable from each. I am grateful that he isn't suffering any longer, but am so heartbroken that I lost my life partner and miss him a great deal.

One psychologist said that losing your spouse is like losing a limb. I agree. Dealing with his loss has been the most devastating event in my life and I can see why people say that it just takes time to heal. The support from my son, our community, and church have been incredible and I don't know how I would have managed without that support. Also, without the Father's Love I would be in a much more grief-stricken state than I am. It's just a heavy heart from not seeing Page everyday as I have for the last 15 or so years after I retired that makes days somewhat sad and long. When those feelings come along and linger, I get out my Padgett books and soon all those feeling disappear and I am a happy person once more.

I appreciate all your prayers, and ask that you continue them, I still need them very much.

CHILDREN'S SANCTUARY NAMIBIA SOCIETY THANKS YOU (CSNS BOARD)

The Board members of Children's Sanctuary Namibia Society (CSNS) would like to take this opportunity to thank all those who donated to the Society in 2019, for opening their hearts and pocketbooks for orphaned children in Namibia. Your generosity is making a difference in the lives of the children and we thank you from the bottom of our hearts.

It has been a busy year of accomplishments on the Sanctuary land at Drimiopsis! Thanks to the many donors who supported CSNS in 2019, there is now abundant and reliable water on the Sanctuary land. A borehole (or well)

was drilled and water tanks were purchased and installed ensuring a clean water source. Your donations also helped to buy bricks, concrete, floors, windows and doors for the "Mother Building" that is on its way to completion and becoming a refuge of safety, food security and unconditional loving care for the orphans.



Currently this is where and how a bath happens on the Sanctuary land.

Despite all this progress, there is still much to be done before the building is ready to house children and their House Mothers. One of the major upcoming expenses is the installation of toilets, showers and a septic system at an estimated cost of \$5,000 CAD. Although the current water system supplies water to the Sanctuary vegetable gardens and Soup Kitchen, there is nowhere on the land for the children to shower or go to the toilet.

Children often arrive at the Soup Kitchen with their beautiful faces obscured by dust and grime, with dirty clothes, unwashed food bowls and dirt-caked hands. The Soup Kitchen volunteers have each child wash her/his hands before receiving their food, but only a single pan of water, replenished by hauling buckets of water from the water tank, is available for more than 70 children to wash up. Sadly, faces, bodies and clothes go unwashed for long periods of time.

Even though the holiday time of giving and receiving is past, we ask those of you who can to please consider sending a donation to Children's Sanctuary Namibia Society. Help

us raise the funds to complete the much-needed Sanctuary showers and toilets.
