THE TRANSFORMATION (RON SHOEMAKER)

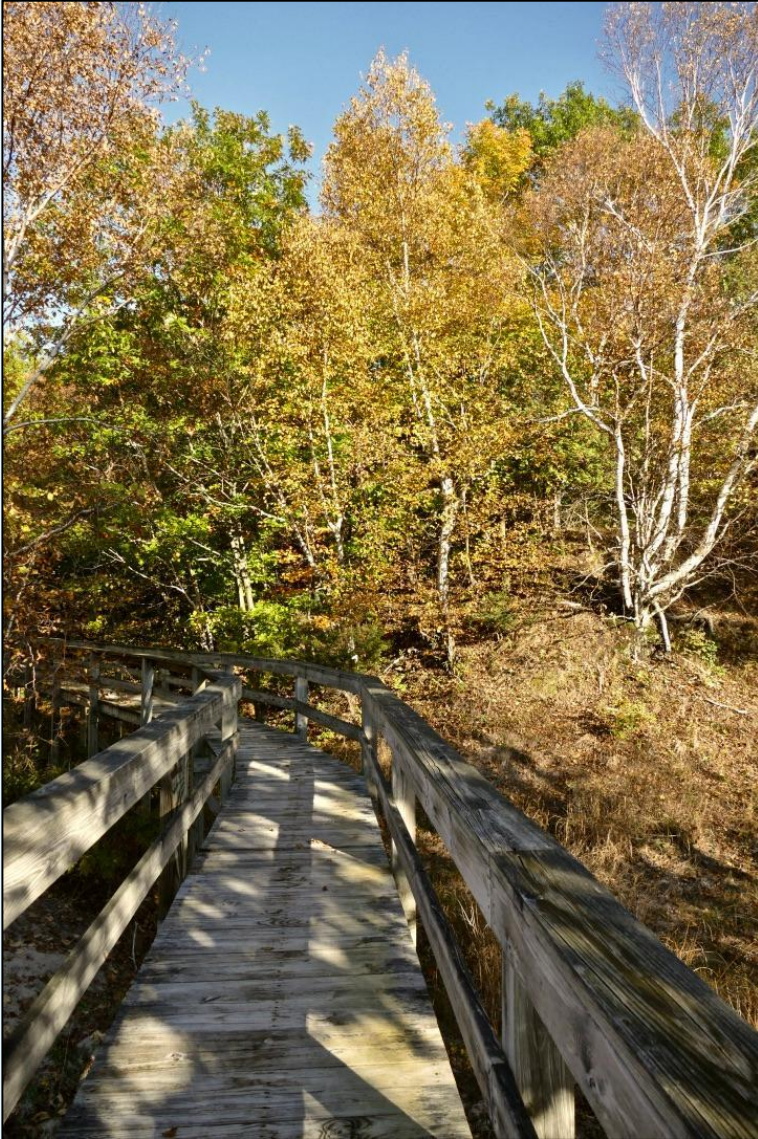

Traveling the Divine Love Path is a journey of discovery. At some point in my spiritual trek, I realized that it was the divinity in the Divine Love that gave it its self-sustaining quality. I pondered this nascent revelation. What does it mean to experience a self-sustaining quality? As I sought to understand, the only thing I was aware of that I could compare Divine Love with was my natural love.

In my quest I found a comment by Jesus in Vol. 1, p. 14 of the Padgett messages. He writes, “The love with which man was endowed, as the perfect man, enables him ... to love God and to love his fellow-man as himself, for this natural love is one that in its perfection and nature is universal, and in its exercise every man is his neighbor's brother.” It seems that in its perfection, the manifestation of natural love has the capacity to be inclusive of all humanity.

Continuing, I came across Jesus’ comments on pp 74-76, Vol. 3 of the Padgett messages: “This love is of the nature that changes with the change in the desires and ideas of man; and has no stability that will serve to keep him constant in his affections.” He seems to be saying that the focus of my natural love would change as it reacts to changes in my desires and ideas. In considering this, I realized that as I mature and my responsibilities change, my hopes and expectations may also change. The intensity of my attachment to a particular view, a view that could wax and wane over time, becomes a vehicle

through which I communicate with others. What I was sure of earlier may not be the case later. My view can become partial rather than universal as my biases narrow my outlook. If I become convinced that certain nationalities are in some way superior, or that one’s ethnicity states something about their humanity, this enables me to partition humanity into various categories, seeing some in a more positive light. This in turn would narrow the focus of my natural love.

Jesus continues, “No man who has only this love can ever be in condition to say that he will continue to have that love for a longer time than the present. ... But this love is one that may last for a long time ..., yet in its very nature it has not that constancy which ensures its lasting longer than a moment of time.” I was reminded of friendships that I thought at one point would be stable and lasting, but as my desires and ideas fluctuated, over time they became less rewarding -- or decayed into oblivion.

I understand this to be saying that my natural love doesn’t embody a guarantee that the object of my affections will always be constant. It is not self-sustaining. If and when my desires and ideas change, this may well influence the focus of my natural love; the compassion I once felt for someone may languish or even cease.

But not to disparage natural love, Jesus writes, “it is undoubtedly the greatest gift that the Father has bestowed on mankind. ... The natural love is that which unites men and women in unity while on earth, and enables them to approach nearer to a life of happiness than any other human quality.”

Then on p. 15, Vol. 1 Jesus says: “When He created man, He gave him a free will -- the most wonderful of the natural gifts to man -- and He will not, by the exercise of His power arbitrarily control the direction of that will, but as to it leaves man supreme.”

All of the experiences, feelings, thoughts, actions, expectations and hopes that I have accumulated in life’s journey will be there seeking to influence my will, which in turn can influence the focus of my natural love; the manifestation of which can fluctuate.

So what is the advantage of Divine Love that has the quality of being self-sustaining -- a love that is not influenced by one’s changing desires and ideas and is independent of all outside circumstances?

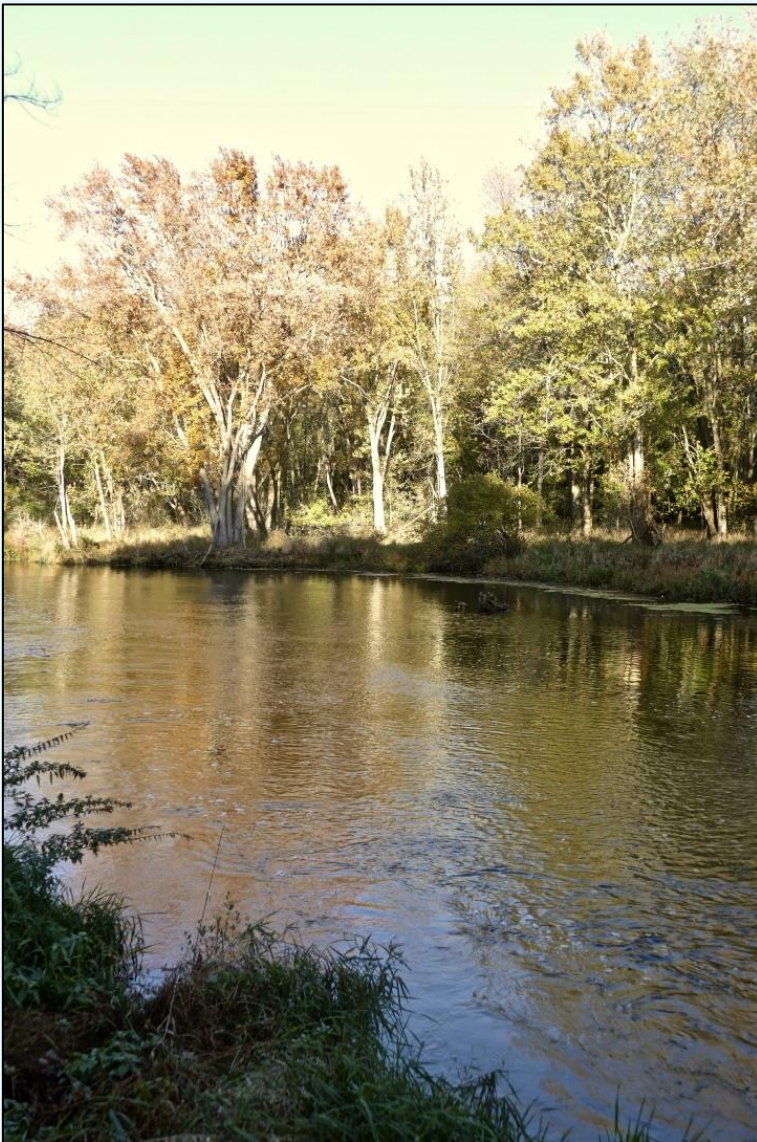

Jesus writes in Vol. 1, p. 60: “Well, to begin with, God is soul, and soul is God. Not the soul that is in the created man, ... but the soul that is Deity and self-existent, without beginning or ending, and whose entity is the one great fact in the universe of being.” It appears that the Deity’s Soul is the original and is the one being in all reality that is authentic and not like the human soul, created in the image of its Creator, one that has a beginning and may have an ending. He continues: “This love of the Father’s own self is of a never changing nature, and in all places and under all conditions is working out the same results and converting the souls of men on earth as well as of the spirits in the spirit world, into not only the image but the substance of the divine nature.” At this point I was beginning to understand what Jesus meant by “being constant.” The focus of the Great Soul’s compassion, empathy and forgiveness are proactive, always present, and always in control, working toward the same goal.

I sought to visualize more clearly what an image was. I thought of my reflection that I see in a mirror. As long as I am standing in front of the mirror, my reflection will be there. No matter how perfect the reflection, when I move away, my reflection disappears. The reflection is not original, nor is it authentic. It has a beginning and may have an ending. It simply appears to reflect the way I look and could be mistaken for the real thing. There is nothing about it that’s self-sustaining.

It is the Deity’s substance of divine nature that is original and authentic. The purity of the qualities embodied in the divine are likewise. Each self-sustaining quality is always present, precisely because it is self-sustaining, never hidden. Each is not

only free from death, but is beyond the possibility of death, never fading or ceasing. In their purity they are uninhibited by the desires and ideas of natural creation. They are truly universal in their focus. Attributes such as compassion, empathy and forgiveness flowing from Divine Love are guaranteed to be permanent manifestations -- whether dealing with a friend or one who has purposely caused unnecessary pain. This is genuinely a new and different creature.

With the transformation, the self-sustaining Divine Love becomes dominant in the human soul and its qualities, which are now guaranteed to be permanent, will become the controlling influence. Ann Rollins writes in Vol. 2 p 81: "Until we reach the first Celestial Spheres, we have not a sufficient quantity of this Love to make us partakers of this divine nature of the Father, in that degree so that all the natural loves are absorbed by the Divine Love."

Our greater at-onement with the Father in his Divine Love means we are able to express these permanent divine attributes ever more perfectly. This transformation doesn't conclude at some future destination but is an unending experience as we continually seek to form a more perfect union with the Great Soul's Love.

In our interactions with one another, let us remember Jesus' farewell discourse as recorded in the Bible, John 13:34: "I give you a new commandment: love one another: just as I have loved you, you also must love one another." And in verse 35 he adds, "By this love you have for one another, everyone will know that you are my disciples."

TRIBUTE TO CATHERINE KOCH (APRIL 28, 1957 - MARCH 28, 2023) (TERRY ADLER)

Catherine Koch passed into spirit in India one month before her 66th birthday, while on her first holiday in four years. Founder of the charity Love is the Answer (LITA), she called her work "love-work" and so it was.

From her earliest years, Catherine enacted love and compassion for family and others. Her mother, June, was fond of telling a story of Catherine's first day in kindergarten. As the two walked into school, they saw a little girl crying and clinging to her mother. Catherine let go of her mother's hand and took the little girl's hand, saying "You don't need to cry. We are going to have lots of fun." Catherine then led the little girl into their classroom, leaving behind one happily surprised mother and one very proud one!

While she was in high school, Catherine's father fell ill. Instead of entering post-secondary education, Catherine got a job to help with the family finances. Her career path led her to many roles equipping her with the tools needed for her eventual work with LITA. Before the age of 25, she worked as a manager, a regional supervisor, and a buyer for a large retail chain with many stores. When that company closed due to the owner's retirement, she became a realtor and an entrepreneur running her own small businesses.

When her parents died in 2000, Catherine took time to grieve and re-evaluate her life. She travelled, learned, and found her purpose. In 2007, Catherine sold her home and went to Uganda with the

proceeds. There she worked with charities, lived among poor families, and learned what the people needed to support and empower them. By 2011, LITA was registered as a Canadian charity.

Through LITA, Catherine had raised over a million dollars. Partnering with communities in eastern Uganda, LITA built six schools and dormitories where orphaned children live and learn along with children supported by their families. LITA has assisted thousands of orphaned and vulnerable children and their caregivers, as well as children growing up in child-headed families, with school fees, mosquito nets, emergency food, medical care, shelter, transport, beds, bedding, solar lighting, and income-generating activities including raising heifers and poultry, and growing food.

Some of the children Catherine first met and worked with in Uganda are now adults and in university studies, thanks to LITA. Two have graduated – one as an auto mechanic, another a chemical engineer. The LITA board intends to build on Catherine’s loving legacy and carry on her work of transforming lives.

Catherine lived her life believing that love is a limitless resource, a sure guide, and the answer to many of life’s problems. She chose love in all she did. In her own words, “I/we have answered the calls/cries of children with as much love as we could. I am so grateful we have had the chance. Every orphaned and vulnerable child I have met over the years, so often very resilient, beyond strong, and always, no matter what, ready to smile and laugh once more.”

In one of her last communications with the board, Catherine shared a poem written by Mother Teresa called “Do it Anyway” that she felt summed up her experiences. Here it is:

People are often unreasonable and self-centred.
 Forgive them anyway.
 If you are kind, people may accuse you of ulterior motives.
 Be kind anyway.
 If you are successful, you will win some false friends and some true enemies.
 Succeed anyway.
 What you spend years building someone can destroy overnight.
 Build anyway.
 If you are honest, people may cheat you.
 Be honest anyway.
 The good you do today may be forgotten tomorrow.
 Do good anyway.
 Give the world the best you have, and it may never be enough.
 Give your best anyway.
 For you see, in the end, it is between you and God.
 It was never between you and them anyway.

I saw Catherine Koch in a vision as she was transitioning. As I watched, her face kept transforming, becoming younger and younger, happier and happier.

Usually when I see someone transitioning, I see them and later hear that they have passed. Many times I do not recognize the person. I am not receiving communication from the deceased, but just seeing them passing. I see a three-dimensional picture, analogous to a human SMS message, to let all know this person is passing on. I guess this is a universal broadcast, that any angel or loved one in spirit can respond to, to attend to the person. (My lovely sister Hunter advised me to pray for the person's transition and thank our Father for giving me a message that I can respond to with love that benefits another person. Unfortunately, am not so diligent in following this advice.)

The message of Catherine's passing was different. As I saw her, her face started to change into a younger and younger, but essentially the same, person. I did not know her name and had never met her, but was surprised because her transition was different from others that I saw in the past. I recognized her instantly when I later saw her picture posted in the Divine Love group.

It was lovely to receive so quickly after her passing through Al Fike her message and a message from the Master on her passing.

- **Lisa Sims** has created a comprehensive compilation of Bible verses about prayer for one-ness with God. The list includes such themes as silent prayer, Divine Love, seeking God, the new heart, new birth, divine nature, being watchful, and more. It can be accessed and downloaded from [here](#). Lisa has found the list helpful in teaching others, especially those with Bible background, about praying for Divine Love. Below is some background on the weekly prayer meetings she has been conducting.

It began with an announcement about a new Bible study/prayer meeting on Wednesday afternoons in the Church bulletin. The pastor also announced it from the pulpit warning, "...there will be silent prayer." After meeting several weeks at the church, the group moved to a member's home. The format consists of one-half hour for reading and discussing a portion of the verse list, followed by one-half hour of silent communion with the Father, followed by one-half hour of singing relevant hymns suggested by the group members. Lisa starts the silent-prayer time with a short prayer. Members are encouraged to pray daily in a similar manner.

The [PDF document](#) is both emailed to participants and printed out for use in the meetings. The most informative verses in it might be: Romans 5:5 – "and hope does not disappoint us because God has poured out His Love into our hearts (souls) by the Holy Spirit whom He has given to us." and 2 Peter 1:4 – "Through these He has given us His very great and precious promises, so that through them you may participate in the Divine Nature and escape the corruption in the world caused by evil desires."

A New Circle (Beth Mazur)

A new circle, The Lightworkers Circle, will take place on the 1st and 3rd Mondays of each month at 4 pm PT / 7 pm ET. The format is a 30-minute, service-oriented prayer where participants ask to be used as channels of love and light according to God's Will. This circle complements the BYS (Befriend Your Soul) Healing circle is held on the 2nd and 4th Mondays of each month. On BYS Mondays, participants pray for those attending the circle (group 1), as well as for healing (group 2). On Lightworkers Mondays, participants pray to be used as channels, i.e., God's choice (group 3). All are welcome at the Lightworkers circle – it is not necessary to have a healing gift. Elizabeth Mack will continue to host the BYS Healing circles and Beth Mazur will host the Lightworkers circles. There will be separate Zoom links for each that will be posted on the WhatsApp prior to each circle.

We had a "soft launch" of the Lightworkers circle for regular BYS attendees on June 5th. Elizabeth Mack received a [message](#) confirming the circle's purpose. She also explained in chat afterwards that Jesus shared that the "experience of allowing God's will to direct this circle without limits imposed by us (i.e., making specific prayer requests) is how we can be most effective in our work and our daily lives and, this is how the soul and the mind work together in harmony, in alignment and at-onement with God."

Condition of the Soul When and After the Divine Love Flows into It
John

As you know, the soul in the condition in which man possesses it before the entrance of the Divine Love is not in accord with the Love of God, nor is it a part of the great Oversoul. It is only a special creation made in the image of the Father, having in

it the natural love which was conferred upon man at the time of his creation, and not having in it any part of the essence of the Father, or any quality that makes it of the Divine nature of the Father, or necessarily immortal.

But when the Divine Love enters into it, and it becomes permeated, as it were, with the Divine Essence, then it takes on the Divine nature of the Father, and to the extent that it receives and possesses this Love it becomes at-one with God and ceases to be a mere image and becomes transformed into the substance.

The soul in this condition is altogether a different entity from the soul in the condition in which it was created, and no longer is subject to the dominion of either the mind or of the animal appetites and desires, and, hence, the spirit possessing such a soul is, in essence, a part of the Father, or as Jesus said, is in the Father and the Father in it.

It is now a thing of love and purity, and consciousness of its true condition is always with the spirit that has such soul. This transformation is gradual, and men must not think that by the mere act of conversion from their state of death they at once become possessed of the nature of the Divine, for such is not the fact. The transformation is gradual and comes according to the susceptibility of the soul to receive this Love of which I speak.

But when once the inflowing of the Love commences, it continues eternally. Although there may be times of stagnation and apparent loss of this Divine Essence, yet always is the transformation taking place, and at certain stages in its progress, the possession of this Divine Love will be so great that the original soul, or its original qualities will entirely disappear and leave only the new qualities which the Divine Love has implanted in it. The leaven when once deposited never ceases to work until the whole shall become leavened.

The Importance of Getting the Divine Love in the Soul

Be true to your best spiritual longings, and you will soon feel that you have got that in your soul which will give you perfect peace and happiness. You are only now beginning to learn that you must feel that your Father is so near you, that He must become a part of your life and being. When that Love has fully taken possession of you, you will know that you are His own true and reconciled son, just as all are who have come into a realization of that Love. So do not doubt that you may become such a son of your Father, for I tell you that I know from my own experience, the grandeur of living in the favor of His Blessing.

Be my own dear boy and do try to reach out and get this Love. You must not let the things of your earth life keep you from the higher things that the Father has prepared to give you. You will soon know, as I know, that the only things worth striving after are the things of this spiritual Love of the Father. Be more anxious to get this knowledge, and it will come to you in all its beauty and convincing force. I so wish that you could see the Holy Spirit's work among men and spirits, for then you would not doubt any more that God is a God of Love, and not of anger or retribution.

Keep praying, for that is the one great means to receive the Love of God. Without prayer men cannot reach the answering ear of the Father's Grace. He will hear the penitent only, for He will not accept anyone who is not truly and anxiously seeking Him. Man has a will to either accept or reject the Love of God, and until he exercises his will in a way to show that he wants that Love, it will not be given him. No man is ever forced to love God or to let God's Love come into his heart.

The Love of God cannot be defined, for it passes all understanding, but the result of that Love, when in the souls of men, can be seen and felt, in the exceeding beauty in the countenances of men, and in their wonderful happiness.

No fear of death or anything that maketh afraid can possibly exist where this Love is. It is not the Love that permits any feelings of jealousy or envy to have an entrance, but is so perfect and all soul filling that there cannot possibly be any room for anything but its own great self. I know that the Love of God is the only thing that can make man supremely happy while on earth, and after he becomes a spirit.

My love for Him is such that I love every one of His creatures, be they saints or sinners. And that is the difference between the love that He inspires in His children, and the love that exists among men and spirits, which has not His Love for its foundation. Be sure that no man can be perfectly happy without this Divine Love.
