# **OBITUARY: REMEMBERING SUSAN KAUFMAN (CAROLYN STOKES)**

Susan passed away on April 1, 2020, after an overnight stay in the hospital. She suffered from asthma and pneumonia. Our condolences to her family and friends.

I was first introduced to Susan by Rev. Bill Asnis, head of FCNB in Santa Cruz, California, in early 1981. We were both members of the church. She was earthy, saucy and had big, chocolate-chip colored eyes with thick lashes. She was a bright and gifted individual, who freely shared of her beautiful contralto voice, and her piano and harp skills. She wrote rock operas, plays, drama and poetry. She also gave great hugs.

A couple of interesting memories that I recall were when Susan and her friend, Eugene, produced (lighting, stage props, costumes, choreography, and rehearsals) a touring musical medley. The performers consisted of herself, and several other church members (she corralled me into joining to help me recover from a bad car accident). We were performing a selection of Loeb, Rogers & Hammerstein songs at senior citizen centers throughout the Santa Cruz area. When she wasn't busy taking care of her daughter, she would play the piano and share prayers and readings from the Padgett messages with the elderly and shut-ins.

Another selfless act was Susan following guidance to leave her home in the Live Oak section of Santa Cruz one sunset afternoon and drive to my home, which at that time (1986) was in Soquel. She didn't find me

there, so she went on foot, looking for me. She found me on a beach (about a mile away from home and before cell phones were popular). I was by myself going through pre-birth contractions, before my daughter, Glorianna was born.

She got me up on my feet and prayed with me. Then she slowly walked and supported me, with many stops to go through the contractions and breathing, to get me safely home. It took us over two hours to get there, as I didn't want her to leave me, even when she suggested it would be faster to go and bring her car closer. By the time we got back to my place, it was late at night.

We lost regular contact after my family relocated to Washington State in 1993. Susan briefly reconnected with us via email and phone in 2013 (she was then living in Brooklyn, N.Y.). In March 2017, she became a regular participant in our Skype, now Zoom, Sunday service hosted from the island of Oahu, HI. Susan performed three of her original songs (that had rock and jazz influence in them) during the services – she periodically graced us with singing "Daddy Come Home," "Prayer Song" and "Divine Love Song".

She is survived by a sister, her lovely daughter, Jessica, who attended the DL Gathering in Windsor, CA in 2013, and lives in Soquel, CA, and her three grandchildren. We miss Susan, as well as her beautiful, big heart. God bless you, sweet soul.

Susan loved requesting us to sing the first song from <u>Songs of Praise</u>, <u>Songs of Joy</u>, entitled "All Day, All Night". The lyrics said, "...All day, all night angels watching over me." Now, she is watching over us. Susan was also honored in the April 2020 issue of The New Birth Commentary: Remembering Susan Kaufman – by Jan Blackston, Minister of the Divine Truths.

It was great to meet new friends who were eager to share their spiritual experiences and open their hearts and minds to the message of God's Great Divine Love. We were cocooned in a tropical garden on a grassy lakeshore of the five-bedroom home of Do Nguyen. The setting was delightful to all the senses, with amazing wildlife, exotic birds, turtles and even spotting an alligator!

We spent four days together in prayer, healing, presentations on emotional integration, opening the chakras, chanting / dancing on the lakeshore deck and feasting on Vietnamese food! We heard heart wrenching stories about our Vietnamese attendees' life-threatening experiences during and after the Vietnam War. Our new friend, Christian Le (Portland, Oregon), shared his terrifying memories at age 7, when he escaped with his mother and brother Daniel in an overloaded boat. During a terrible storm that threatened to capsize the boat, Mother Mary came to the brothers manifesting her angelic presence.

### Cooperation with AREI

Thanks to Patricia Doyle and her wonderful team who hosted the Divine Love Retreat in Phoenix, followed by AREI Symposium in Scottsdale, AZ, in September, 2018, connections were made with Founders of AREI (Afterlife Research and Education Institute), Wendy and Victor Zammit. # CORONAVIRUS CONTEMPLATION (EVA AND ALEX PECK)

We're living in a very tumultuous time — in many aspects, unprecedented. Day after day, sobering news reports emerge — both of the COVID-19 spread and its casualties, as well as its impact on society, especially the economy. Some of us may have lost jobs and are struggling financially.

The entire world has dramatically changed in a remarkably short time. It was



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only at the end of December, 2019, that a young doctor, Li Wenliang, sent a message to other medics about a new virus in Wuhan in Hubei Province of China. Now, only a few months later, the whole world is in various degrees of lockdown.

This is a time for young and old to stop to ponder life – its instability and uncertainty. We are blessed to understand life's higher purpose and destination. But while still on earth, what should be our focus and values to remain resilient and sound-minded, to avoid excessive feelings of stress, fear and anxiety so prevalent in the society, and to be a light to and able to help others? Here are a few reflections using the acronym C.O.R.O.N.A.V.I.R.U.S.

**CALMNESS**: Despite the turbulence, may we live from day to day with an abiding calmness, peace, and clarity of mind, enabled by taking additional time to pause, reflect, pray for ourselves and others, and especially ask for God's Love.

**OPENNESS**: Let's keep an open mind to what is unfolding and what these dramatic events may be teaching us about our individual lifestyles and the civilization as a whole. Will some of the deeply-rooted structures and entrenched power bases need to change?

**REFLECTIONS ABOUT REALITY**: Let's deeply reflect on the realities of life. All things are impermanent and come to an end – sometimes very quickly and unexpectedly, such as the untimely death of a loved one. Therefore, it's important to make the most of our time and opportunities, helping others and engaging in positive deeds while we can.

**ONENESS**: From this present crisis, let's appreciate anew the intricate inter-connectedness of all humanity and the entire web of life on the earth – how we are all in this together as one human family, how we are all interdependent, as well as dependent on other species. This contrasts with the predominant focus on an independent self (egocentricity), with everyone largely looking out for themselves.

**NEW NORMAL:** While many are asking when will things get "back to normal", others feel that for the welfare of all, this would not be the best way forward. In reality, the "normal" that we have known and gotten used to in the Western world has not been working for humanity except for a relatively few. When we take an unbiased look at the various crises around the earth, it becomes increasingly clear that new norms need to emerge. There is an urgent need for a new world based on cooperation, kindness and caring, rather than competition, and the pursuit of power and possessions. Some see the present

pandemic as a catalyst for the formation of new and better approaches. We can each pioneer this new vision by choosing love in all that we do.

ACCEPTANCE AND APPRECIATION: In the present situation, it's easy to slip into denial, fear, anger, and even depression — or obsessing about getting what we want, and trying to avoid what we don't want. Instead, may we accept what is, and appreciate in a new way what we have. Appreciation and gratitude are powerful positive states that increase immunity and promote wellbeing. By accepting and appreciating whatever situation we find ourselves in, we can make the most of our opportunities and reach out to help others less fortunate.

**VISION**: Some have postulated that our civilization needs a new vision for humanity. Such a vision would include a world where *loving-kindness* has replaced anger, hatred, enmity and war; where *cooperation and humility* have replaced competition, arrogance, superiority and pride; where *generosity* has replaced greed, miserliness, selfishness and hoarding; where *wisdom* has replaced darkness, confusion, delusion and misperception; where *contentment* has replaced envy, jealousy, clinging and covetousness. Embodying such values on a worldwide scale



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would return us to a golden age on earth (which according to ancient spiritual writings, as well as scientific and archaeological evidence, had existed before and is destined to return).

**INDIVIDUALISM**: A great deal of suffering arises from a predominantly "I", "me", and "mine" orientation – desiring happiness only for ourselves, without the thought of how to benefit others. The present crisis is pointing to the need for cultivating altruistic love and compassion – being sincerely concerned for the wellbeing and happiness of others, and for them to be as much as possible free from suffering.

**RESOLUTIONS**: This time of crisis can be a good time for new resolutions, for example: to maintain hope and faith that some good will come out of the pain; to keep a peaceful mind, no matter what happens; to be patient and gentle with people and situations; to let bygones be bygones, leaving behind past hurts and regrets; and to cherish each day, knowing that life can change, or end, quickly.

**UPROOTING UNWORKABLE PARADIGMS**: For some time now, scientists and other concerned people have been saying that the consumer-driven "good, comfortable life" enjoyed by many of us in the West is unsustainable for the planet. The fact that a relatively small percentage of earth's population consumes a mammoth share of the earth's resources, in an environmentally destructive manner, can no longer be acceptable. May the present crisis powerfully reinforce the need to uproot unworkable modes of operation.

**SOUL SEARCHING AND SPIRITUALITY:** This time of upheaval affords an ideal opportunity to spend extra time in prayer and meditation -- to turn within into the depths of our hearts and souls, and to seek more of our Father's Divine Love as well as guidance how we can be instruments of light and hope in this dark world. May we help others realize that peace, happiness, and freedom from suffering cannot be achieved by looking to people, possessions, or pursuits of status, fame and power, but rather by turning to a loving God, who desires only the best and highest for all His children.

# How to Pray for and Experience God's Divine Love (Michael Nedbal)

Praying to our Heavenly Father for His Divine Love is the single most important thing that we can do. Taking the first step toward a regular prayer practice sets in motion a host of angels working behind the scenes to assist us in preparation to receive God's Divine Love and to help us develop a close, personal, and deep relationship with God that will intensify for all eternity. God will meet us more than half way in establishing a loving relationship: "God wants and is patiently waiting for the love of man".1

How do we make the start? How do we pray so that God hears the earnestness in our soul longings? Jesus states "...that men shall believe with all the sincerity of their



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minds and souls that this great Love of the Father is waiting to be bestowed upon each and all of them, and that when they come to the Father in <u>faith and earnest aspirations</u>, this Love will not be withholden from them. In addition to this belief, <u>pray that He open up their souls to the inflowing of this Love</u>..."<sup>1</sup>

Ann Rollins suggests to James Padgett: "Let not your desires originate from only the intellectual, but try to bring the longings of the soul into being. <u>Do not rest satisfied until a response shall come</u>, as it will certainly come. You will know that the Love is present and working its transforming power upon the soul." The Padgett Messages clearly show us the way. Yet, many of us still find making that initial connection challenging.

When I first learned about the availability of God's Divine Love, it took me quite some time to feel a connection with God. I felt that I obtained a response after I devoted myself to at least 20 minutes of focused prayer, three times a day, for three weeks. During this time I kept a journal about my experiences and what did and did not work. I'm including a summary of these notes below in the hope that some of it may resonate with you and assist you in your prayerful desire to connect with our Heavenly Father.

### **TECHNIQUES OF PRAYING FOR DIVINE LOVE**

**Schedule:** Set a goal to formally pray three times a day for at least 20 minutes each time. You may not always achieve this, but do the best you can. If you are still working, your morning prayer can take place while driving to work. Believe it or not, I had my most intense Divine Love experiences while driving. Your midday/afternoon prayer can be during your lunch break, and your evening prayer can be more formal with a specific location and time designated. The important point is to have a goal and try to stick to a schedule. If you can make prayer a part of your daily routine, you will more likely stay with it.

**Location:** During your formal prayer in the evening, find a private or semi-private place and make it your holy sanctuary. Find a comfortable position, perhaps a candle to focus your mind, incense or anything that makes you feel spiritually elevated. Generally, I wouldn't recommend using your bed, which is for sleeping, while your intention is not to sleep but to connect with God.

**Mindset:** Our purpose in praying is to establish a relationship with God and keep growing closer to Him through the reception of His Divine Love. However, avoid specific expectations as to what you are going to experience. Expectations can be a form of control, as well as a source of disappointment. Also, if you are expecting a burning sensation in your chest, you are not allowing yourself to be open to other ways that the Father may bless you. So, be completely open.

Make it ok if nothing physical or spiritual happens. Be gentle with yourself and enjoy the experience of being centered and raising your energy. When I first began my dedicated prayers, I simply felt peace. There are many on the Divine Love path that do not experience physical sensations concurrent with the inflowing of the Divine Love.

This is a time for you to connect with God. Praying for others is important and has its own rewards for you and those you pray for. However, dedicate this time to establishing your personal relationship with God.

Below are some specific notes that I made to myself.

- Have faith and trust. Faith in God is vital trust that your life
  is going to turn out well, and that wherever He leads you, it will be for the best. Also important is faith that Divine Love is waiting to be bestowed on you and will enter into your soul if properly asked for. You don't need to "heal" your emotions or past sins prior to receiving God's Love. Divine Love will transform and heal your soul.
- Ask for help. "All progression depends upon the help that comes from outside the mind or soul of man"<sup>3</sup>. Professor Salyards continues, "... if a man depends upon his own powers, exclusively, he will never progress. And this law does not apply only to the soul's progress ... but also to the progress of the mere mind, and also to what might be called the purely moral qualities".<sup>3</sup> I used to think that if I were spiritually strong enough, I could progress on my own. This belief was not in harmony with God's Law of Progression<sup>4</sup>.
- <u>Pray for the right reasons</u>. Is the reason to be ahead of everyone else, or to become a member of an elite group (the Celestials)? Or, is the reason to be at-one with God, to be in His Love forever? Are you praying for advancement or because you love God and want to be with Him?
- <u>Be in a state of gratitude</u>. Take the time to consider your life and the blessings that you have received. Appreciate our beautiful planet and your brothers and sisters who are on the same spiritual journey. God has given you so much because He loves you. Soulfully appreciate everything He has given you and thank Him for it.
- Be open and relaxed. Stress from our daily life puts up a wall to the inflowing of the Father's Love. The Love will not come in if we have negative thoughts or are thinking about something else. Think of your soul like a flower that needs to open in order to receive God's Love. When it is closed due to stress or other factors, it is not allowing the Divine Love to flow in. Ask the angels for help in letting go of the stress.
- <u>Pray with all your heart</u>. Jesus said to James Padgett, "I do not want you to think that you are now in a condition that leaves you free from sin or from the necessity of appealing to the Father with all your heart for an inflowing of His Love". 5 Your heart and soul need to be engaged in praying for God's Love. Like the Prayer Perfect concludes, "We pray thus with all the earnestness and sincere longings of our souls ..." 6

A few more observations are worth considering.

- First, there seems to be an ebb and flow to progressing in the Love. God's Divine Love will flow intensely for a while and then it may not be felt as strongly for a period. This is a normal process and it doesn't mean that you are doing anything wrong during the slow periods.
- **Second**, it is important to not only pray to receive God's Divine Love, but to also give your love to God and others. Some come to a plateau in receiving the Love if they don't reach out in love.

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◆ Third, and very important, is surrender to God's Will. This is not easy and it may take time to completely surrender. It may feel scary in that you may think the Omnipotent God might do something that causes you to lose your identity. You may fear that God will have you do what you don't want to do. These thoughts of the mind couldn't be farther from the truth. Your identity actually comes alive when you surrender because you stop taking on identity projections from your family and friends. And God won't ask you to do anything that you don't want to do. He wants you to be happy and desires your actions to be anchored in love and never forced or have a basis in fear.

I finally took the leap of faith and jumped off the cliff surrendering my soul and my life to God. I prayerfully asked God to take my soul and my life. That was the turning point in my prayer and the time when I really started to feel connected with God.

Below is a short introductory prayer to the Prayer Perfect which is designed to "teach the spirits" and ask for help in preparing the soul.

"Dear Heavenly Father, thank you for this opportunity to connect with You and receive Your blessing of Divine Love. I ask, Father, that if there are any spirits present who are not open to receiving Your Divine Love, and are here to cause discord and distraction, that they be removed and taken back to their homes in the spirit world until they can return in harmony with your Love. I ask that my soul be in ascendancy over my mind and to know Your Truths. I ask to let go of all that is not in harmony with Your Love. I ask to be surrounded by Your Light and Love and lifted up toward your Celestial Kingdom, where I may make rapport with my spirit band, in order to receive assistance in opening my soul to the inflowing of your Divine Love." Then, continue with the Prayer Perfect or your personal prayer.

If you need more preparation time to release the stresses of the day, meditate for a period to center yourself before going to Father. After the prayer, I will sometimes hold the thought of asking for God's Divine Love. At other times, when I am in need of specific guidance, I will clear my mind and ask for help with a particular question or issue. I communicate to the Father that I am open to any guidance that He may convey through His angels.

There will be times when you get discouraged and feel unworthy. Know that you are a beautiful child of God. He loves you because you are His child, not for what you do. Make a daily affirmation to tell yourself "I am a child of God and worthy of His Love".

# FUND-RAISING IN THE TIME OF COVID-19 (TERRY ADLER)

We in First World countries are mightily challenged by the restrictions and other fallouts from this recent pandemic: loved ones may be affected, routines are disrupted, outcomes are uncertain. Yet, those with whom we are connected in the Third World are far more vulnerable as they have so little to begin with.

Some of us in the Divine Love Community are particularly concerned about the welfare of a San Bushmen community in Drimiopsis, Namibia that our dear friend, Helge Mercker, introduced us to in 2014. The children are especially vulnerable due to the HIV/AIDS infection of their parents/caregivers. Over the past few years, several Divine Love Community members (Al and Jeanne Fike, Geoff Cutler, Terry Adler, Betty Owen, Judy Dunbar, Diane Mawson, Kevin O'Neill, and Arie and Marion Hordijk) traveled to Drimiopsis and witnessed the amazing efforts being made by local leaders together with Helge and the Children's Sanctuary Namibia (CSN) board to provide care for the children.

Those of you who in the past contributed to this cause helped make possible the construction of a Sanctuary for the children orphaned by AIDS. However, the building has yet to open its doors to provide shelter, education, food, security and loving care for the most vulnerable from among those looked

after. To achieve this, we require funds for food, furnishings, electricity and water, as well as medical care, staff salaries, and training. Never has the need for such a shelter been more urgent.

Due to COVID-19 closure of businesses, Drimiopsis wage earners have lost their jobs. Schools have been closed. Numbers of children coming to be fed through the trice-weekly CSN Soup Kitchen have risen. The only help given by the Namibian government is monthly per household N\$200 per child (\$15.50 CAD), a bag of mealie meal and cooking oil.

Judas, the Apostle, Discusses What the Best Thing Is for Men to Do Who Desire to See God and Realize That He Is a

Personal God with All the Attributes That Belong Only to a Supreme, Infinite Being

Let me write, Judas.

I have not written you for a long time and feel that I must write you and declare some truth that is of importance to you and to mankind. I will not write a very long message, and what I have to say will be put in short sentences and made succinct. I know that you wonder who I am and what I will write about, and you must not be surprised if I tell you what you may think is not of much importance.

Well, my subject is, "What is the best thing for men to do who desire to see God and realize that he is a personal God, with all the attributes that belong only to a Supreme, Infinite Being."

God is a spirit and a person, and not a mere nebulous being without form or personality. He is real as to these qualities, and is not wanting that which will make him the Father that Jesus so often called him.

Now in order for a spirit to see and understand just what all this means, the spirit must get in that harmony with Him that will enable the spirit to possess qualities of soul that is like the qualities of the Father that the spirit desires to see and understand. This condition can be obtained only by the spirit pursuing the way that the Master so often writes you of, and which is absolutely necessary in order for the spirit to obtain the qualities necessary for such comprehension. **Only as a soul is filled with the Love of the Father can it possibly be in the condition that will enable it to see and comprehend this personality of God.** No mere development of the intellectual faculties or of the natural love will suffice for this purpose; and while such development is necessary in order for the spirit to become the perfect man in order to enjoy the condition that belongs to that man, yet such development is not sufficient to enable the spirit to see and comprehend the Father.

It is much easier for a spirit to get in the condition just mentioned than to get in the condition last described; and as you may see the wholly different thing that the development leads to, (this) should be sufficient to induce the spirit to accept the Father's Love, and become a true son of His.

I have written what I desired, and thank you for the opportunity, and with my love will say good night.
