FROM THE EDITORS

Welcome to the five-year milestone of the Divine Love Newsletter! This is the thirtieth issue of sharing news and stories across the Divine Love Community. In this issue we share several inspiring stories. UPCOMING EAST COAST RETREAT (CATHERINE KENT)



Divine Truth Sharing is hosting a retreat in the Washington, D.C. Metropolitan Area entitled **2020 Vision: Living the Divine Love Journey between 8 - 12 October 2020**.

Enrich your personal experience of living in the world as a true child of God, deeply appreciating and actively seeking His Divine Love each day. The more we understand what it means to be in a genuine relationship with God, the easier it is for us to *receive*, *discern*, *and follow the tender guidance* of our Loving Creator, moment by moment. Come to learn and share on this guided retreat. All activities, topics and workshops will support a single focus: *Living the Divine Love Journey*.

We are all called to pray directly, soul-to-God, to grow in our Father's Love. Divine Love soul development is most effectively achieved in our lives when we are able to *receive*, *discern*, *and obey the guidance* that comes to us privately, through our own prayers. Yet, few people know how. This retreat will help participants learn how to receive and discern their own personal guidance through prayer, which requires its own study and practice. Everyone will be strongly encouraged to use free time during the retreat to connect with others and to practice, as much as possible, what they are learning, to experience God directly, when no medium is present to provide a channel.

The retreat will be offered *at cost*, with every effort made to minimize expense. Unity in Diversity (Eva Peck et al*)

When the above retreat was first introduced via a group email to gauge interest, a sizable number of community members responded and shared their thoughts and insights. While one or two misinterpreted the retreat's purpose, others did a wonderful job putting things into perspective. It is these inspiring comments, as well as my own, that I thought were worthy of sharing with the newsletter readership.

Historically within the Divine Love community, the one thing that has been disagreed on is whether contemporary mediated messages are inspired or not. Some rely heavily on and cherish messages received through present mediums within the community, some appreciate channelled messages, but consider them secondary to the Padgett messages and personal guidance, and some pay no attention to contemporary messages, believing that they are just coming from the medium's mind. This kind of range of views on any subject is not unusual in a spiritual community, and it doesn't have to be a problem or divisive when certain factors are understood. These two Bible passages (among others) sum up where we as Divine Love community stand and what we should aspire to.

1 Corinthians 12:12-31 -- The body is a unit, though it is made up of many parts; and though all its parts are many, they form one body. So it is with Christ. ... But in fact God has arranged the parts in the body, every one of them, just as he wanted

them to be. ... The eye cannot say to the hand, "I don't need you!" And the head cannot say to the feet, "I don't need you!" But God has combined the members of the body and has given greater honor to the parts that lacked it, so that there should be no division in the body, but that its parts should have equal concern for each other. ... Now you are the body of Christ [joined together by the Divine Love] And in the church God has appointed first of all apostles, second prophets, third teachers, then workers of miracles, also those having gifts of healing, those able to help others, those with gifts of administration, and those speaking in different kinds of tongues. [various gifts and functions] ...



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
1 Corinthians 13:2-13 — "If I have the gift of prophecy and can fathom all mysteries and all knowledge, and if I have a faith that can move mountains, but have not love, I am nothing. ... Love is patient, love is kind. It does not envy, it does not boast, it is not proud. It is not rude, it is not self-seeking, it is not easily angered, it keeps no record of wrongs. Love does not delight in evil but rejoices with the truth. ... Love never fails. But where there are prophecies, they will cease; where there are tongues, they will be stilled; where there is knowledge, it will pass away. ... For we know in part and we prophesy in part, but when perfection comes, the imperfect disappears. ... And now these three remain: faith, hope and love. But the greatest of these is love."

Or, from the letter ascribed to Paul to the Romans:

Romans 12:4-18 – "Just as each of us has one body with many members, and these members do not all have the same function, so in Christ we who are many form one body, and each member belongs to all the others. We have different gifts, according to the grace given us. If a man's gift is prophesying, I let him use it in proportion to his faith. If it is serving, let him serve; if it is teaching, let him teach; if it is encouraging, let him encourage; if it is contributing to the needs of others, let him give generously; if it is leadership, let him govern diligently; if it is showing mercy, let him do it cheerfully. ... If it is possible, as far as it depends on you, live at peace with everyone."

It's clear that the Divine Love community is greatly diverse. Our diversity should be celebrated for it clearly shows God's Love has no limits nor boundaries in which it can flow and reach us. We are all His children, remarkable and wonderful, and what makes us so unique is the very thing we should honor and appreciate in each other.

All of us are parts of the divine whole of Creation, on a spiritual journey to realize our connection with the whole and its Author, helping one another progress through our unique perspectives and gifts. On this spiritual journey, we are also our brothers' and sisters' keepers. One of our dear brothers, drawing on his own recent experience, described it like this: "You can imagine someone on a journey, maybe travelling on the same road with you. Then you are ahead. You look behind and you don't see him except once in a while, you get a glimpse of him. Then he, somewhere, slowly, gets off the road, sits on a pavement, puts his cheeks between his hands, and looks down, thinking and contemplating. He may not have given up the journey, but



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he stagnates and loses hope. Imagine if he suddenly gets out of his deep thoughts only to see his friends coming back for him! He jumps up! And smiles! They talk to him. He cannot sit again -- that care and concern alone has given him a jump start. He immediately starts moving -- having received a boost for his whole life."

We can all thank our Father for this brotherhood/sisterhood of mediums and of not-mediums, of those willing to differ, if that's what comes for them to say, of sincere seekers with their own unique gifts. Hello and welcome to all of us whom God has created and whom He loves without condition!

Let's pray that our Divine Love community is one of mutual acceptance, loving unity, under the same banner, with no one excluded especially for their gifts which God has blessed us all with to help one another. There is no place for the "us" and "them" in this equation. We should always be inclusive and finding a way for all to join in, and then to truly celebrate our differences and our gifts together which will give us true strength.

SERVICE AND SOUL AWAKENING IN NAMIBIA (HELGE MERCKER)

"If we pray, we will believe; If we believe, we will love; If we love, we will serve." - Mother Teresa

These words of Mother Teresa reflect the truth, for as we pray for the Divine Love and grow closer to God, we realize the urge to serve God and follow His Will in deeper ways. The desire to love with God's Love and to fulfill our soul mission becomes more evident to our consciousness. One way of serving – God uses us in many different ways – is in reaching out in love to our poor and disadvantaged brothers and sisters in society. An example of this is providing love and service to the San people in Drimiopsis, Namibia.

For ten days in August 2019, Divine Love soul sisters Betty Owen, Judy Dunbar and Diane Mawson came to Namibia to join me in my work at the Children's Sanctuary serving orphans and vulnerable children in the local San community. Those days in Drimiopsis were filled with a great sense of harmony and being in the flow of God's Love. This was the result of a singleness of purpose amongst us, for each was devoted to praying for God's gift of Divine Love and to being used as His channels of love. As founding members of the board of Children's Sanctuary Namibia Society, all four of us held the children, the Sanctuary land, and the volunteers deeply in our hearts and prayers. At their first meeting with Chief Ita and Theresa Matengu (founding members of the local Children's Sanctuary Namibia), Judy, Diane and Betty felt an instant deep soul recognition with them. We knew that God had brought us together through the power of our collective prayers; truly a deep blessing for us all.

We spent hours each day on the Sanctuary land with Chief Ita, the soup kitchen volunteers, and the orphaned children. As school was out, we hosted a daily soup kitchen feeding 75 orphans and dozens of other children from the community. Thanks to a generous donation, the children received a special food item with their meals, such as meat, oranges, apples or peanut butter sandwiches. They truly relished these unexpected treats!

Chief Ita invited community elders to the Sanctuary land for daily healing/prayer circles held after the children's meals. Many of the children joined the prayer circle which was very special with God's Holy Touch felt by all. Even the birds came close and joined in as we gathered underneath a thorn tree. It was a rare privilege and a powerful, cross-cultural experience for the three Canadians to be with these resilient souls, each speaking their prayers aloud to God from their hearts and sharing songs and stories. (You are welcome to simultaneously join us in our prayers as these circles continue daily at 3 pm Namibian time.)

Our visitors spent three mornings at the Kindergarten where they enjoyed a real hands-on experience with the staff and children. They were warmly welcomed by the teachers and were impressed the teachers' by commitment and caring for the students. CSNS (Children Sanctuary Namibia Society) enjoys a special relationship with the Kindergarten as the Society funds its daily food program and Diane Mawson's North Vancouver, B.C. Kindergarten class is a "buddy class" with the Sanveld Kindergarten. Our guests brought to

the school a variety of books, games and other teaching resources and enjoyed introducing some of these to the delighted staff and students.

The days were filled with laughter, joy and harmony. As we gathered around the evening fire reflecting on the day's work, we came to recognize that our desire to serve brought us into the flow of God's Will with each moment. It was a prayerful and joy-filled time. Our humble prayers to be instruments of God's Love opened our souls for His Love to flow. As love flowed, hearts opened and we connected with others in love. Through working and praying together, bonds were strengthened and deepened.

The lack of focus on the material poverty, neglect and desperation that surrounded us in Drimiopsis was surprising. Rather, we were struck by the richness, beauty and openness of the souls we met in this place of such austerity and need. Their ability to be so present and willing to connect on a soul level was an unexpected gift to us. What our physical eyes saw did not register as profoundly as what our souls "saw" in each moment. As we moved in this flow, we experienced the warmth and welcome of community members, especially the children. Serving in love, we were loved and cared for. We felt blessed in the reciprocity of giving and receiving; our hearts felt rich and happy. Francis of Assisi spoke truth when he said "For it is in giving that we receive."

One of our guests commented: "During our time on the Sanctuary land in Drimiopsis, our souls expanded in love and sang with the realization that this trip was a deep blessing and an answer to prayer. So much of the soul was revealed, opened and given through the loving act of service and much was received. We discovered the reciprocity of giving by stepping forward without expectation, being present with openness, honesty and love. The results were beautiful, surprising, uplifting and abundantly soul affirming.

"After leaving, our service to God continued as we ventured north to Etosha National Park to be amongst God's Creation. We prayed deeply for the land, for rain, for the people and the animals. The angels accompanied us on our journey and helped us to experience spectacular animal sightings. The blessings and gifts continued through our heightened awareness of the deep harmony inherent in God's Creation."

As we grow on our spiritual path of Divine Love, our ultimate mission and soul destination is service. The form of service is often determined by the gifts within. Prayers and deepest soul longings for our Father's Divine Love help us to expand the light and hone the gifts of our soul. They are the vehicles to get us to our destination by revealing the sign posts for the direction we must travel in our service to God.

THE KEY TO THE CELESTIAL HEAVENS (RON SHOEMAKER)

The transformation of the human soul from a finite condition to one of infinite possibilities requires a radical change. In John 3:3 in the King James Version of the Bible, Jesus is responding to a question asked by Nicodemus: "Verily, Verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be *born again*, he cannot see the kingdom of God". The same verse in the Revised Standard Version says: "Truly, Truly I say to you, unless one is *born anew*, he cannot see the kingdom of God".

This is not referring to the Golden Rule as a guide to finite moral perfection. Rather, the phrase "born again / anew" speaks of a vision and a transforming experience that takes one beyond the pinnacle of moral perfection into a New Reality -- a completely new being with unlimited hope. This astounding experience is the New Birth. The expectations, hopes and

experiences embedded in the infinite possibilities of the Divine Love are an unimaginable paradigm shift from the world of the finite natural love and moral perfection.

To envision the difference between the natural love and the Divine Love, think of your most meaningful experience, your favorite scene that has been made into a two-dimensional puzzle. Each of the many pieces that make up the puzzle have

length and width. When all pieces are properly in place, the picture represented will lie flat. Its dimensions will only be length and width. Think of this as our natural love, a love with limits that it cannot go beyond. When someone causes you unnecessary pain, you may find it difficult to love that person the way you did before. In this sense, the finiteness of our natural love is exposed. Our love for the perpetrator may fade from our consciousness or perhaps cease.

Now think of a three-dimensional puzzle of the same meaningful scene, each of its pieces having length, width and height. When all of the pieces are in place, it not only lies flat on a surface, it also occupies some of the space above it. This three-dimensional puzzle is one way to think of the Divine Love. It has a depth that the other is lacking. It has the possibility of reaching even greater heights. While the two kinds of love may appear to have similar qualities such as empathy, patience and forgiveness, their natures are radically different. The pinnacle of moral perfection is the finiteness that our natural love cannot go beyond. With the transformed soul, the Divine Love never fades or ceases. Imbedded in such a soul is unlimited hope and its continuing manifestation into the unending future. Trying to mesh the pieces of these two radically different realities is not possible. The two-dimensional puzzle's pieces are incompatible with the pieces of the three-dimensional puzzle.



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So, what would happen if a person with only the natural love were to enter the Celestial heavens where the two-dimensional world of the natural love would meet the three-dimensional reality of Divine Love? The two-dimensional pieces of the one would be incompatible with the three-dimensional pieces of the other. Trying to mesh them would only create dissonance and frustration. Everything would be out of kilter from the perspective of the natural love – a world turned topsy turvy.

Thinking of another way to view this conundrum, imagine a physically heavy person wanting to buy clothes in a clothing store that specializes in sizes for small people. Every article of clothing the customer would try on would be too small. None of the clothes would fulfill the person's hopes and he or she would always be disappointed, frustrated and unhappy.

Therefore, there is no place for the natural love soul in the Celestial Spheres. The aspirations and hopes of a soul conscious of its natural love is at home in the natural love spheres where it is compatible with the surrounding environment.

The key to the Celestial Heavens is the transformed soul – a soul so filled with the Father's Essence that all vestiges of its former natural love have ceased to exist. Only a soul imbued with His Authentic Love can understand and interact with such an environment. The Celestial Heavens are the doorsteps to the Divine where the Essence of Divinity abounds ... providing a transformed soul a peek at the One perfect embodiment of Immortality.

The destiny of the natural love soul is radically different from that of the Divine Love soul. The aspirations and hopes of each lead to different realities ... and never the twain shall meet.
