# UPCOMING DIVINE LOVE RETREAT, MARCH 8-12, 2019, MEYERSDALE, PENNSYLVANIA



Divine Love Radio (WDLR) and Divine Love Sanctuary Foundation are cohosting a Divine Love Retreat in Meyersdale, in South Western Pennsylvania, March 8-12, 2019. A small town famous for its Maple Industry and annual Maple Festival, Meyersdale is nestled in Amish country in Somerset County. It is becoming a world-known Trail Head community along the Great Allegheny Passage. The Passage is a 350-mile "Rails to Trails" bicycle and hiking trail from Pittsburgh, PA to Washington, DC with no vehicular traffic.

Yoder's Guest House will be the hub of our activities. The hosts, Denise and Chuck Gehringer, have blocked out our dates and will close to the general public during the retreat time. Reservations will need to be made by phone since online reservations are now blocked. Should the rooms fill up, accommodations are also available at the Levi Deal Mansion just a short walk up the street from Yoder's. # **DIVINE LOVE SURVEY RESULTS - QUESTIONS 1-12 (EVA PECK)**

In early July, FCDT sent out a survey on the backgrounds and experiences of Divine Love followers. Its purpose was to learn of Community members' experiences on the Divine Love path in order to bring us closer together. What was most surprising was the diversity of responses. We do not come from similar backgrounds, have not discovered the messages at the same period in our life, and a lot of us were not even searching for the truth. The results show how God's wonderful diversity extends to the lives of those embracing His Divine Love. We would like to thank all those who participated and anonymously shared experiences and insights from their personal journey. In this issue we are publishing a summary of responses to the first twelve questions. We hope that you will find it interesting, inspiring and personally helpful.

## 1. At what age were you first introduced to the Divine Love?

Between the ages of:

0-10 = 2

11-20 = 5

21-30 = 12


31-40 = 8

41-50 = 1

51-60 = 7


61-70 = 8

> 71 = 3




## 2. Was there one major event in your life that led to the discovery of the Truths of God's Love?

- No major event, but rather a series of events some
  have searched for or desired to know the truth for years
   17.
- Meeting someone, including a medium, who directly or indirectly led them to the Padgett messages – 11.
- Personal crisis a combination of factors and/or passing of a loved one (mother, wife, sister-in-law, aunt) – 10.
- Supernatural event out-of-body experience with Jesus, angel visitation, miraculous life-saving intervention, a sign from God, sudden awareness of higher truths, soul awakening after surgery, answered prayer – 7.



# 3. Were you seeking "the Truth" and finally found it in the Messages?

- Yes -24 51%.
- No / not sure / not specifically / just "stumbled" onto messages – 19 – 40%.
- Messages made sense/resonated in the soul, confirmed held beliefs, answered puzzling questions and doubts – 2 – 9%.



## 4. How many years have you been a follower of the Divine Love teachings?

Less than 2 years – 5%

3-5 years – 8 – 20%

6-10 years – 5 – 12%

11-15 years – 2 – 5%

16-20 years – 8 -- 20%


21-25 years - 1 - 3%

31-40 years – 4 – 10%


41-50 years - 7 -- 17%

51+ years -- 1 (70 years) - 3%




## 5. How did you first learn about God's Divine Love?

- Through a friend or an acquaintance (incl. invitation to a DL Prayer Circle) – 19.
- Internet (Geoff Cutler's site, a spiritualist website, AJ Miller) – 13.
- FCNB/FCDT publications or through another book on the topic (two mentioned Life in the World Unseen by Anthony Borgia) – 8.
- Spiritual experience (revelation from Jesus, relationship with God since childhood, NDE) 3.
- A progression of events, for example dissatisfaction with life leading you to a church, which led you to ... which eventually led you to the Divine Love messages – 2.



## 6. What religion or spiritual belief, if any, did you follow prior to finding the Divine Love?

- Protestant denomination (e.g., Presbyterian, Lutheran, Adventist, Methodist, United Methodist) - 17%.
- Catholic 24%.
- No religion, just a belief in God, or "spiritual, not religious" - 11%.
- Other 15%, which includes:
  - Some church involvement, but later left.
  - Non-mainstream Christianity or have studied non-Christian religions including Judaism, Buddhism, Hinduism, Sufism, Taoism, Bahai, New Age and esoteric teachings.
  - Several reported many stepping stones along the way to finding the Divine Love truths.




- 7. Were you following a spiritual path before learning of the Divine Love, e.g., did you have a regular daily prayer routine and/or studied spiritual writings?
  - No spiritual path or quest 28%
  - Following a spiritual path 72%, such as:
    - o Regular or occasional prayer (15),
    - Spiritual reading the Bible and/or other materials
       (16),
    - Meditation (10),
    - Regular or occasional church attendance (8),
    - Being a spiritual seeker.
       [As would be expected, some have practiced more than one of the above.]



# 8. Do you feel in retrospect that you had been receiving the Divine Love before you understood it through the Padgett / Samuels message?


• Over half, twenty-five (54%), believe that they had been receiving the Divine Love before understanding it through the messages. Some have learned about it elsewhere (e.g., a Jesuit retreat or A.J. Miller), some had had a relationship with God or longings for God, even though church teachings didn't resonate with them, some understood it differently (e.g., in terms of the Holy Spirit), but when they read the messages, the teachings resonated.



- Eleven (24%) were unsure.
- Ten (22%) felt that they had not been receiving God's Love.


## 9. What state of mind were you in, or what emotions did you feel when you first learned of God's Love?

- The vast majority of the respondents 40 (87%) reported feelings ranging from positive to elated and jubilant, at having found the truth. Descriptions ranged from and included "light went on", "it made sense", "loved it and wanted to learn more", "homecoming", "amazement and fascination", "great joy", "jubilation" and "bliss". For several of these, the messages confirmed what they had believed or suspected.
- Six (13%) reported emotions ranging from disinterest, skepticism, confusion and disbelief, internal conflict of the mind rebelling against the truth, and fascination followed by anger about having been lied to. As they kept learning, they came to acceptance of the teachings.



# 10. Have you experienced the inflowing of the Divine Love? If so, how would you describe it in spiritual and/or physical terms?

- Fifteen (31%) specifically mentioned a burning or another sensation in the heart/chest area.
- Sixteen (33%) reported a combination of feelings, including tingling and thrill bumps, being enveloped in light, movement of waves, and flowing of tears. Some of the feelings were indescribable and occurring in various parts of the body.
- Thirteen (27%) spoke of, in some but not all cases in addition to the above experiences, of spiritual uplift, energy shift, transformation, peace, joy and even bliss.
- Four (8%) said they had no specific feelings or sensations despite diligently praying for God's Love.



## 11. Has this experience changed over time? If so, in what way?

- Sixteen (36%) reported that their experience has not changed over the years.
- Twenty-seven (60%) reported changes over time of various kinds including deepening, intensifying, increased awareness, transformation, healing, more love, sensations affecting a larger area of their body, sensations being less grandiose and overwhelming, and increase or decrease in frequency.
- Two (4%) were unsure.




# 12. Have you ever experienced expiation (i.e., the soul purging itself of sins and dark encrustations as a result of inflows of God's Love)?

Twenty-six (56%) reported the experience of expiations.

A wide range of physical, emotional, and spiritual experiences were described relating to both past and present events in people's lives. They included physical pain, in some cases intense, body tenseness, painful dreams and visions, emotional highs and lows, moodiness, worry, fear and anger, internal conflict, experience of healing and transformation, disharmonious energy patterns leaving with or without conscious awareness, forgiveness, including selfforgiveness, and letting go of encrustations and inherited traits.

- Sixteen (35%) weren't aware of any expiations.
- Four (9%) weren't sure.

As more people accept the content and viability of the Padgett and Samuels messages, there will be those joining the Divine Love Community that come from around the globe and have a wide variety of backgrounds. Each individual will have his or her particular frame of mind – the glasses through which they will view the messages. At the beginning, most of us are intellectual Christians. The truths the messages proclaimed somehow make sense within the puzzle of our mindsets. As we trek the Divine Love trail, the experience of the Divine Love will add substance and meaning to our intellectual knowledge – adding ever greater depth to our insights.

As more people with a variety of backgrounds choose to join the Divine Love Community, we may not always intellectually agree on the way the messages ought to be interpreted. When this occurs, we ought to remember that we all belong to the Divine Love Community and that we are all seeking the Truth and striving to experience its reality. It is also good to remember that while we may all be walking on the same path, we will not all be at the same point along the way. The view that one person has may not be the same as another person's view. What seems clear to one may not be so to another.

In addition, we ought to remember that each one of us will bring our unique way of understanding this work. But it is the flowering of the Divine Love in each soul that will reveal the meaning of Its Truth to each person if they will allow it. These revelations do not come all at once, but gradually form a mosaic of unimagined beauty.

So let us not set ourselves up as judges, condemning others for their views or actions in this work. Rather, let us be patient, ready to help and guide when possible, knowing that the Divine Love in our souls is working constantly to make known Its mysteries to each of us – we are all in the shadow of God's Love.

In closing, it is the Divine Love that ought to unite us, not whether we agree intellectually. Let us not forget the Eleventh Commandment that Jesus referred to in the 23rd Revelation received through Dr. Samuels and found in John 13:34-35 where Jesus says: "I give you a new commandment: love one another; just as I have loved you, you also must love one another.
